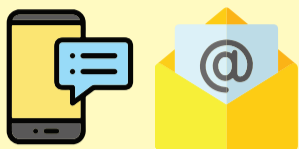


Registration Steps at Wits in 2023

1



- If you are made a firm offer, you will receive an SMS offer and a firm offer letter via email from the University
- Please follow the instructions in the letter

- Access self-service <https://self-service.wits.ac.za/>



- Accept an offer and register online before the deadline stipulated in the firm offer letter



- SA citizens are required to pay the first fee payment before registration
- International applicants are required to pay at least 75% of the year's tuition fees before being able to register, and will require clearance from the International Students Office



- Click the Fee Estimator tab to generate an annual fees estimate for an academic programme that you are either active in or have applied for



- If you cannot make this payment or are awaiting NSFAS feedback, complete the First Fee Payment option after accepting an offer. (You will be required to pay tuition fees in full for the year by the end of May 2023)



- Residence applicants must have accepted the residence offer and paid the deposit in order to be allowed into a residence after registration

- Access the www.wits.ac.za/mywits/student-email/ to activate your Wits Student email and other services e.g. Gateway to Success, Ulwazi, etc.
